The New Mexico State University Office of International Student and Scholar Services (NMSU ISSS) is a dedicated department committed to supporting the diverse community of international student, staff and faculty at the university. As a key component of NMSU's commitment to global engagement, NMSU ISSS strive to enhance the overall internationalization experience and facilitate a smooth transition for those coming from around the work to study, teach or conduct research at the New Mexico State University.

Services Provided by NMSU ISSS:

- Immigration Support: NMSU ISSS offers comprehensive immigration support, including guidance on visa applications, maintain legal status, employment authorization, and other related immigration matters. We assist international student and scholars in understanding and complying with U.S. immigration regulations pertaining to F-1/F2 and J-1/J-2 visas.
- 2. Orientation and SEVIS Check-In Programs: Upon arrival, international students and scholars receive tailored orientation programs that help them acclimate to the NMSU campus, local community, and American culture. There orientations cover various aspects, including academics, campus resources, health care, cultural adaptation, employment authorization and health insurance.
- 3. Cross-Cultural Events and Workshops: NMSU ISSS organizes and hosts various cultural events to promote cross-cultural understanding and engagement among the international and domestic communities at NMSU. These events encourage cultural exchange and appreciation.
- 4. Scholar Services: NMSU ISSS extends its services to visiting scholars, researchers and faculty member from other countries. We assist with administrative process, immigration matters, and facilitate connections with relevant academic departments.
- 5. Advocacy and Support: NMSU ISSS advocates for the rights and needs of international students and scholars within the university community. We work closely with other university departments to address any challenges or concerns faced by the international community.
- 6. Scholarships and Funding: NMSU ISSS helps international students explore available scholarship opportunities and funding options to support their education at NMSU.
- 7. International Student Organizations: NMSU ISSS supports and encourages international student organization, fostering a sense of community and providing platforms for sharing traditions, customs and experiences.

Highlights from The Year

During the time between July 2022 to May 2023, NMSU ISSS has achieved significant highlights and points of pride, demonstrating our commitment to providing exceptional support and resources to the international student and scholar community at NMNSU.

- Return to In-Person SEVIS Check-In Sessions: AS the pandemic restrictions eased, NMSU ISSS successfully resumed in-person SEVIS Check-In Sessions. This allowed us to personally welcome and assist incoming international students, providing a smooth transition to campus life and academic endeavors.
- 2. Optional Practical Training (OPT) Workshops: NMSU ISSS organized two informative OPT Workshops on February 9, 2023 and March 8, 2023, to guide graduating students through the employment authorization process. These workshops empowered students to pursue valuable practical experience in their fields after graduation enhancing their career prospects.
- 3. Partnership with Aggie One Stop: We established a fruitful partnership with Aggie One Stop to serve as the ISSS front desk, ensuring seamless guidance for in-person visitor to our office. The collaboration enhanced accessibility and improved the overall service experience for our international students.
- 4. New Front Des and Waiting Area: With a focus on creating a welcoming and safe space, we, with the help of Loretta Campolla-Ybarra and Seth Miner, implemented the construction of a new front desk and waiting area for the NMSU ISSS Office. This enhancement aims to provide a functioning workspace for the NMSU ISSS student employees and, a comfortable environment for international student seeking support and assistance. We will continue to work with Aggie One Stop when there is a gap in coverage at the ISSS Front Desk.
- 5. Attendance at NAFSA Regional Conference: In October 2022, out team attended the NAFSA Regional Conference in Flagstaff Arizona, enriching our knowledge and expertise in international education and immigration regulations. This conference allowed us to stay abreast of industry trends and best practices.
- 6. Re-designation of J-1 Exchange Visitor Program: On February 10, 2023 NMSU's J-1 Exchange Visitor Program was successfully re-designated for another two years. This accomplishment reflects the quality and dedication of our services enabling continued opportunities for cultural exchange, collaboration and research.
- 7. Re-certification of F-1 International Student Program: On September 9, 2022, NMSU received recertification for the F-1 International Student Program. This achievement affirms our commitment to meeting federal compliance standards, ensuring seamless immigration support for international students at NMSU.
